The Council met on February 6th and agreed that the ideas & results of the surveys received from our church family will be shared with the Trustees and/or Deacons depending, on the topic, for further consideration. We participated in a Leadership Retreat at Camp Greenwood led by Pastor Jason on March 3<sup>rd</sup> focusing on strategic planning for 2018. Pastor Jason will attend the Michigan NACCC Ministerial Convocation in Adrian April 9-12. A new member class will begin after Easter. The Deacons, Women's Fellowship and the Trustees will be planning an ordination ceremony & celebration for Pastor Jason this spring. The Trustees meet the 4<sup>th</sup> Monday of each month. All are welcome to attend.
