This book details the experiences of a young woman who was raised in the church, left the church as a young adult, searched for the church, started her own church (which failed), and describes what a church should be. Other source books are: Changing the Conversation: The 17 Principles of Conflict Resolution, and Changing the Conversation: The Third Way for Congregations, both by Anthony B. Robinson, a Presbyterian minister, and The Five Dysfunctions of a Team by Patrick Lencioni, and of course, The Bible.
