Did you hear about the fire in the sanctuary a few Sundays ago? June 9th was Pentecost Sunday and we tried out a few new visuals to help embody the idea of the Holy Spirit descending and filling the believers on that birthday of the Church. We had a cool streamer banner that processed in at the beginning and out at the end of the service. We had twelve candles (of various sizes and shapes) to represent the tongues of flame on the heads of the Apostles. We even had this cool water and fire thing going on in the baptismal font, "I baptize you with water for repentance, but one who is more powerful than I is coming after me; I am not worthy to carry his sandals. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire." (John the Baptist in Matthew 3:11 NRSV) In addition to the water in the font, there was a three-wick candle to represent the Holy Trinity. It was all very cool. Well, of course I would say that because I'm the one who schemed it all up and assembled it (with the help of my lovely and talented wife, Megan). You know how odd we pastors are, right?

Let us know when it is, and we can direct people into the groups as we all join together in one united effort to seek and to hear God's voice.
