Many of you are aware of the struggle to keep up with coffee hour over the last couple of years. While the comradery and fellowship coffee hour provides is very important, a significant part of Sunday services for some members, the fact is that roughly half the congregation on any given Sunday does not come down to the Fellowship Hall. As the deacon responsible for Mutual Ministry tasks, Deb D. has been feeling rather guilty assigning people to coffee hour twice a year (more often for some) when many of those people more typically head home after services. The Deacons are aware of the situation and have debated possible solutions for several months.
