

While we are sheltering at home from the COVID virus, the Deacons would like to kick off a weekly Zoom **meeting**. Here is the agenda for the Zoom meeting: Each person states what they are grateful or happy for during that week, what they are frustrated with or need encouraging and prayer for during that week, and a scripture is read. We close with prayer. The whole "meeting" takes 30 minutes. Depending upon how many people participate in the call, we may decide to separate into smaller groups to make sure there is time for everyone to speak during the 30 minute call. Logging into zoom is really easy. On a computer, go to www.zoom.us. It will automatically download and take you to a page where in the upper right hand corner you have an option to: JOIN A MEETING. Click on that and put in the meeting id box: 320-002-2759. If you are joining the meeting from your cell phone, go to your Ap store and download the Zoom Ap. Then select the JOIN A MEETING option and put in the meeting id box: 320-002-2759. When given the option, be sure to select join with video. This is a free and very user friendly way to stay connected through your computer or phone.
