

Is offering FREE COVID-19 Testing on Aug. 4th from 3-7pm at Baldwin Heights Elementary. This is available to the community free-of-charge. Here is some additional information:

- Available for anyone over the age of 18 who wants a test, even if you have no symptoms.
- o No appointment is needed.
- No screening is needed.
- No doctor's order is needed.
- Please bring a form of ID.
- o Bring your insurance card(s).
- o There is a drive-through clinic (stay in your cars).
- o Antibody testing will not be available.
- o People with high-risk jobs are encouraged to attend.

CHURCH SERVICES GUIDELINES

- Greeters at front & back doors (wear a mask, use hand sanitizer, have your temp taken).

- The Service has been streamlined and there is less singing and speaking by the congregation.
- The offering will be collected by the ushers at the end of the service as you exit the sanctuary.

- Take everything with you when you leave bulletin, other papers, trash, etc. & either deposit in a waste can or take home with you.
