- 1) 53 total voters.
- 2) 44 ballots all in favor of all 3 proposals.
- 3) 1 ballot against all 3 proposals.
- 4) 3 ballots in favor of the first 2 proposals and opposing the last proposed amendment.
- 5) 5 ballots had random votes between the 3 proposals.
- 6) 2 comments indicating the quorum needs to provide the actual number required to conduct business.
