NEW MEMBER SPOTLIGHT

Here are the first two Members we want to highlight:

- Bonnie Braman: Bonnie has been a member of FCCOG for 46 years. She is widow of Hal, who was a faithfilled, friendly face at FCCOG for years. She has two sons, one daughter and three grandchildren. One of her favorite things she mentions about FCCOG is the wonderful lifelong friendships she has developed with other members.
- The Wickerhams: Lynn and Bonnie have been members of FCCOG for 55 years. Lynn is a retired sergeant from the Greenville police department and Bonnie is a retired preschool teacher. They have 2 sons (Brent and Brett), 2 grandsons, and 1 greatgrandson.

UPDATED COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

During the past 14 months, FCC of Greenville has done very well in keeping our congregation and staff safe from COVID-19. The safety protocols incorporated into our daily and weekly lives at the church have helped create an environment in which Covid hasn't spread, people haven't died, and many of our members feel comfortable to attend in person. Our Preschool can claim the same happy outcome. Sadly, the same cannot be said for most other churches in our area. We thank God for this blessing!

Still, Covid continues to be active in our community. There are currently several cases hospitalized at SHUM, some on ventilators, a number of local teens recently diagnosed after exposure at the prom, and enough Montcalm County adults and teens still unvaccinated to cause concern. Therefore, while we will definitely be easing up a bit on some aspects of our safety plan, we're not going to throw everything out and return to 2019 practices just yet.

- In accordance with CDC recommendations, those of us who are fully vaccinated (both shots plus a two-week waiting period afterward) are now able to come to church without a mask. Keep in mind, you are still welcome to wear your mask if you are more comfortable with it.
- In accordance with our State and CDC guidelines, anyone who is unvaccinated or not past the 2- week period after their last vaccine must be masked. Children over 2 years old who have not been vaccinated also must also be masked upon entering our church.
- Once Sunday School and Praise Choir start up again in the fall, we may reinstitute some mandatory maskwearing for a while until our children under 12 are also eligible for the vaccine.
- Greeters at the front and back doors will continue to be stocked with thermometers, hand sanitizer, and extra masks, just in case.
- Maintaining a 6-ft. social distance within the building is still wise, and the pews will remain marked off so we're using only every other row. Reminder: Social distancing is also important in the lobby, the narthex, and the elevator.
- The Order of Worship will continue to be streamlined for a while, and Coffee Hour will not return just yet.
- Within the next couple of weeks or so, hymnals and Bibles will be returned to the pews.

Obviously, this is all uncharted territory, friends. We will continue monitoring the effects of the Coronavirus in our community & state. Tighter protocols could become necessary again for the safety of all. Thank you so much for your positive attitudes throughout!
